

About those flowers!

There are several options for adhering your flowers to the background. In the examples below you can see differences in the two end results.



Flowers and leaves with fusible

- This piece is more formal, and has a much more “finished” appearance
- During the composition of the arrangement flowers, leaves and stems were added at the same time.
- After the entire piece was fused, the arrangement was machine quilted, and then the background was quilted.



Flowers were pinned, and basted without any fusible

- The flowers were machine appliquéd down, and the edges are very raw
- The leaves were added as an afterthought, after the flowers were sewn down and machine quilting finished.
- The leaves have fusible, after they were placed, they were machine appliquéd.
