

## Fruit Stripe Gum Part 2

Ready to sew...here we go!

Here are the cut NFNW (non fusible/non woven) interfacing squares

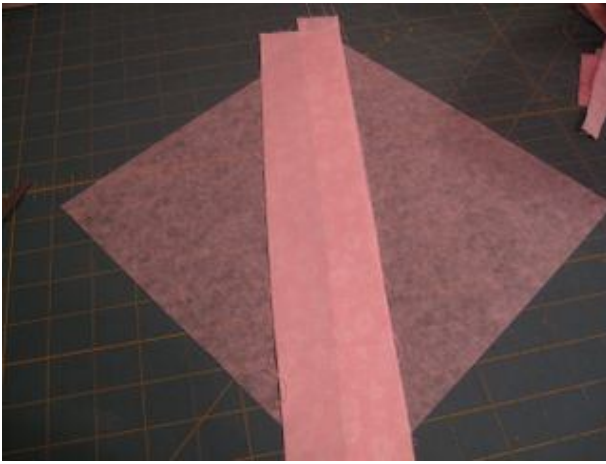


Take your sorted strips of fabric (remember to sort by color)



Take a square of NFNW interfacing; lay it down on the flat surface, on the diagonal.

Place a white fabric strip in the center right side up, and lay a colored strip on top of it, right side down, stitch (1/4" seam allowance), press open. **\*\*Important note: Reduce the heat of the iron to medium when pressing open the strips. A too hot iron will cause the NFNW interfacing to shrivel.**



Add another strip of white, stitch, press open



Continue to add fabric until the entire block is covered.

Here are the colors, and # of blocks included in the Fruit Strip Gum Quilt:

Yellow 5

Green 5

Orange 4

Pink 5

Blue 6

Purple 5
