

LITTLE BOUQUET QUILT • SUPPLY LIST

About this quilt...

You can make this quilt in two sizes, either 10.5'' x 10.5'' or 16'' x 21''. The instructions and supply list will be for the larger quilt, but feel free to make the smaller quilt if you desire. Remember that this is a scrap project, very little is exact in terms of yardage, and quantities. Have fun, don't stress, and enjoy the process!

Fabric for the base:

- Green strips in a range from light, medium, to dark. Select fabric that is less, rather than more patterned. Too busy would be too distracting!
- Strips should be a minimum of 7'' long, widths ranging from 1'' to 3''
- How many? Approximately 100 strips

Fabric for the roses:

- Lots of scraps in silk, batiks, throw in a little velvet if available
- Select fabric with a minimal pattern, select colors pleasing to you...whatever they may be
- Size - all sizes, with a minimum of 2'' sq for the centers

Other Fabric:

- For the leaves - leafy fabric, silks, plaids, something green, minimum 1/8th of a yard
- For the back - a fat quarter
- For the binding - something nicely contrasting; plaids are good!

Supplies:

- 1/2 yard of non fusible, non woven interfacing...thin, thin, thin
- Standard thread for piecing in a neutral color (gray is good), quilting thread in a variety of colors and texture.
- 20'' x 22'' piece of thin batting
- Normal quilting and sewing supplies
- 1 yard of fusible webbing - repositionable is best!
- Sewing machine in good working order
- A sense of humor, and some good cheer 😊
